

TRAVEL ADVISORY FOR DOMINICA



We welcome you back to Dominica, the Nature Island of the Caribbean! Dominica remains committed to providing visitors to our shores a safe travel experience from arrival to departure. We have therefore implemented several measures to safeguard both locals and visitors while on island.

PROTOCOLS FOR PRE-ARRIVAL

Compulsory requirements for all arriving passengers/ travelers.

ALL TRAVELERS MUST:

1. Submit a health questionnaire online at <http://domcovid19.dominica.gov.dm/> at least 24 hours prior to arrival in Dominica,
2. Show the notification of clearance to travel.
3. Submit a negative PCR test result recorded within 24-72 hours prior to arrival

GENERAL PROTOCOLS AND GUIDELINES UPON ARRIVAL:

1. Travelers are required to wear face masks at all times during the arrival process up to and including departure from the airport.
2. Travelers must observe physical distancing guidelines.
3. Travelers must practice good respiratory hygiene and personal sanitization.
4. Travelers must follow all instructions of health care staff and officials.



DISEMBARKATION AND TESTING:

TRAVELERS WILL:

1. Be required to sanitize their hands at sanitization stations as directed.
2. Be required to undergo a health assessment to include a temperature check.
3. Provide confirmation of the health questionnaire and negative PCR test results.
4. Be required to undertake rapid test screening and subject to a negative test result; the following will apply:
 - Travelers will be sent to immigration for processing and to customs for screening.
 - Luggage to be sanitized upon arrival at airport when taken off conveyor belt.

HIGH TEMPERATURE, HIGH RISK ALERT FROM QUESTIONNAIRE OR POSITIVE RAPID TEST:







1. Travelers will proceed to secondary screening area.
2. A PCR test will be administered to the traveler.
3. Travelers will be sent to mandatory quarantine at a government approved facility or government certified hotel at traveler's expense while awaiting results.
4. If the test result is positive, traveler may be quarantined until released by an authorized Health Professional.

DEPARTURE FROM DOMINICA



1. Vehicles will only be permitted to enter the air and seaport with the driver and persons due to travel.
2. Travelers must wear face masks at all times during the departure process until departure from airport.
3. Travelers must observe physical distancing.
4. Travelers should practice good respiratory hygiene and personal sanitization.
5. Follow instructions of health care staff and officials.

 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified vehicles will be sanitized before and after each trip. • Limited contact between passengers and driver. • Passengers and driver to wear face mask at all times inside of the vehicle. • Hand sanitizer will be available for passengers use within the vehicle. 	 <p><i>Trafalgar Falls, Middleham Falls, Emerald Pool, Spanny Falls & other High-Volume Sites</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adhere to opening hours, days and times when visitors can visit sites. • Handwashing facilities will be clearly visible. • All contact areas including railings will be sanitized every hour. • Public washrooms will be sanitized every hour. • Hikers are advised to hike in a single line, practice social distancing protocols and give way to oncoming hikers. 	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of persons in pools will be limited. • Social distancing protocols must be adhered to. • All areas will be thoroughly sanitized after every use. 	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The number of passengers per water sport vessel will be limited to 70% capacity to allow for physical distancing. • Physical distancing between patrons (individuals or groups) will be enforced. • All guests should have their temperatures taken prior to boarding the boat. • Vessel will be sanitized before and after every excursion. • Water equipment will be sanitized after each use (life jackets, snorkel, kayaks, pedal boats, banana boats, oars, etc). • Frequently touched areas within the dive shop should be sanitized every hour including counters, shelves, racks, door handles, and any area that may come in contact with the guests. • Alcohol-based hand sanitizer will be made available for guests. 	 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Reservations are encouraged. • Restaurant tables will be set at least six feet between tables. • Tables will not be pre-set. • Cleaning and sanitizing protocols to be observed. • Restaurants will be sanitized three times a day (after breakfast, after lunch and after dinner service). • All tables and chairs will be sanitized after every guest. • Menu options – Disposable menus provided, use of chalk board, or menus will be sanitized after every guest. • Hand sanitizers will be available for guests. 	 <p><i>Accommodation facilities will be certified to operate under Health and Safety guidelines.</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Temperature checks will be done at all entrances for guests, employees and suppliers. • Luggage will be sanitized upon arrival at accommodation. • Bellmen will use disposable gloves when handling bags. • Procedures will be in place to manage suspected cases of COVID-19 in guests and employees. • Social distancing measures will be in place for guests and employees. • Hand sanitizer stations, touchless where possible will be placed at key guest/public locations.
